History

This half term, we are delving into History with Changes in Britain-Victorian History. Children will learn about Queen Victoria and her significance as a monarch. They will learn about what life was like as a child and how key changes, like the Education Law, ensured young people had better treatment and more opportunities. Lastly, we will explore key advancements in science and technology, such as the

Our Art Unit this half term explores the work of William Morris and the technique of printing. Music
