Substantive Knowledge

- **Abstract** art is a type of art which shows something differently to how it looks in real life.
- Examples of **abstract** artists include Susan Stockwell and Matthew Cusick.
- **Felt** can be used to make artwork but also for useful objects.
- **Felt** is made by layering wool in different directions, adding hot water, the rolling and squeezing it.
- **Abstract** artists sometimes mix colours by overlapping different materials.

abstract	A type of art which may make an object look different to how it usually looks.
composition	Putting different materials together.
curator	Someone who looks after art in museums.
felt	A material made by layering wool fibres.
fibre	Threads of wool.
inspired	Feeling excited by something you have seen.
negative print	Ink that shows a background rather than the drawn lines.
pattern	A design where shape, colours or lines are repeated.
stained glass	Colourful, decorative glass which makes a design.
view finder	A tool used to help choose a composition.
