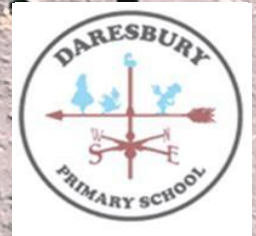


# Year 3 – Spring Term



## English

## Maths

We will be focusing on:

- Multiplication and division of 3, 4 and 8.
- Multiplying by a 2-digit number.
- Length in kilometres, metres and centimetres
- Mass in kilograms and grams.
- Volume using millilitres and litres.

## Science

Light and Shadow

- We can see because our eyes sense light.
- Darkness is the absence of light.
- Objects are easier to see if they reflect light.
- Shadows are formed on a surface when an opaque or translucent object is between the light source and the surface.
- The light from the sun can damage our eyes.

## Art

Painting – Prehistoric Art

- Recognise the processes involved in creating prehistoric art.
- Use simple shapes to build initial sketches.
- Create a large-scale copy of a small sketch.
- Use charcoal to recreate the style of cave artists.
- Demonstrate good understanding of colour mixing with natural pigments.
- Discuss the differences between prehistoric and modern paint.



## Geography

### Naples

- Naples is the third largest city in Italy.
- The climate in Naples is mild and wet winters and dry and hot summers.
- There is a network of caves and tunnels that run underneath the city of Naples.
- Mount Vesuvius is near Naples. It is the only volcano in Europe to have erupted in the last 100 years.
- Pompeii was the city destroyed by the eruption of Mt Vesuvius.

## History

### The Stone Age

- The Stone Age lasted for 3.4 million years and ended with the invention of metal tools.
- The Stone Age is divided into three main periods: Palaeolithic; Mesolithic; Neolithic.
- During this time-period, humans made tools and weapons from stone in order to hunt.
- The first art was created during The Stone Age – humans drew on cave walls and stones.
